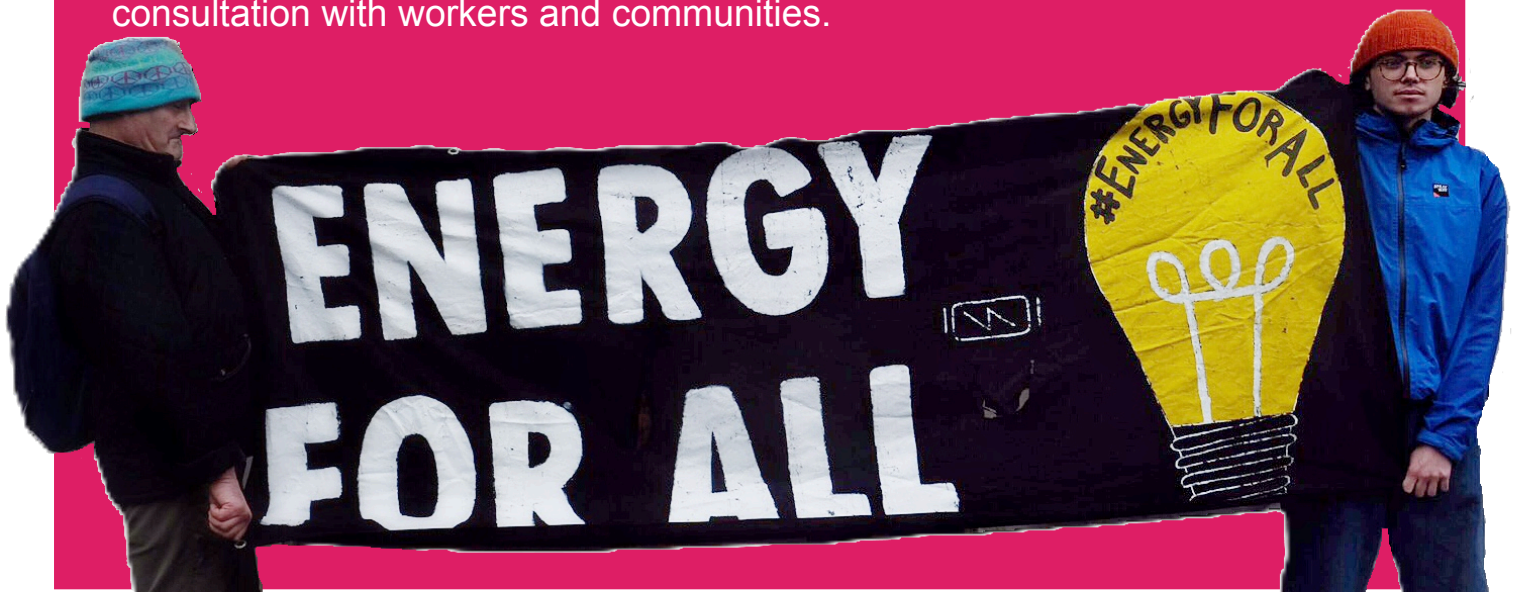
It is not fair and not necessary for people to suffer in cold homes in winter, overheat in summer, cut down on essential use of electricity and go hungry, just to pay huge bills...

FUEL POVERTY ACTION CAMPAIGNS FOR AFFORDABLE ENERGY FOR ALL!

- **Free energy for each household, covering essential needs.** This will be paid for by higher tariffs on luxury energy use, by windfall taxes on fossil fuel corporations, and by taking back the millions spent on subsidising the fossil fuel industry.
- **UK housing upgraded with safe, non-toxic, non-flammable insulation** appropriate to the building. Good quality heating systems must be installed by skilled workers in consultation with residents.
- **A permanent ban on the forced installation of prepayment meters and on forced disconnections** from energy supplies.
- **An end to energy injustice**, where many of the poorest people pay the highest bills; a just transition to renewables for cheap, green energy, in consultation with workers and communities.



CLIMATE CHANGE IS COSTING LIVES

Huge oil companies are destroying the climate and threatening everything we hold dear, for the sake of their profits.

Renewable energy from the sun, waves and wind can be CHEAPER than gas and oil.

Far from making us poorer, the transition away from fossil fuels will bring us more affordable energy, better housing, cleaner air, and will help keep down the cost of food by helping to stabilise the climate. Climate change is already causing floods, droughts, and famines around the world, and driving up prices everywhere.

We're a group of ordinary people fed up with being robbed by greedy energy companies through spiralling bills, and landlords who rent out damp, uninsulated homes. Alongside trades unions, pensioners groups, disabled campaigners, tenants' organisations and others on the frontline of fuel poverty, we're using protest and direct action to fight for affordable energy that meets our needs instead of just racking up profits.

Energy For All has massive support all over the UK. Over 660,000 people have signed our petition. 75% of respondents supported the idea in a national poll. The Trades Union Council, over 250 organisations and businesses, and many MPs agree.
